











Grass Growth - AFBI Hillsborough and CAFRE Greenmount Plots

## **MANAGEMENT NOTES:**

- On farm grass growth has been level or above L.T Avg. of grass plots. Forecasted growth is predicted to drop in the next few weeks.
- Grazing demand (kg DM/ha) will continually change throughout August as silage
  areas become available for grazing and if reseeded areas come back in or are
  removed from the platform. Grazing livestock numbers and intakes vary
  depending on the system so this will influence demand.
- Managing bloat risk is important to consider as clover contents increase and grass DM% decreases. Best practice is to avoid turning animals into lush, low DM% swards hungry, use 12hr wires to graze swards out and provide a supplement fibre source.
