MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Grass growth remains above the LT av. despite the difficult weather conditions.
- The reason for building grass covers over the past 4 weeks now becomes clear as growth will begin to drop below demand on many farms if nothing is changed.
- High amounts of rainfall, especially over the past weekend have made grazing conditions challenging, especially when trying to graze and utilise high grass covers.
- Grass DM is low, keep animals well fed and consider supplementing forage for fibre
- Consider grazing lighter covers until conditions improve to increase the grazing area
- Use the full range of autumn grazing tools and techniques where applicable, including on-off grazing, using multiple entry and exit points, using spur roads to access the back of paddocks, using 12 hour allocations and back fencing grazed areas.
