

Week Beginning 12th July 2021



MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- This week again sees growth rates significantly limited by soil moisture deficit, as a result of little or no rainfall. Unfortunately, with very little rain expected during the next two weeks, grass growth forecasting models are predicting current conditions to persist.
- Grazing fields have headed out and grass is becoming stemmy. Topping will be necessary to get quality back into swards for the next rotation.
- Revise winter feed budgets now to allow time to source alternative forage options, if necessary, for the winter months.
- Where reseeds have been sown but haven't yet germinated, seeds should still be viable and should germinate when sufficient moisture is present.
