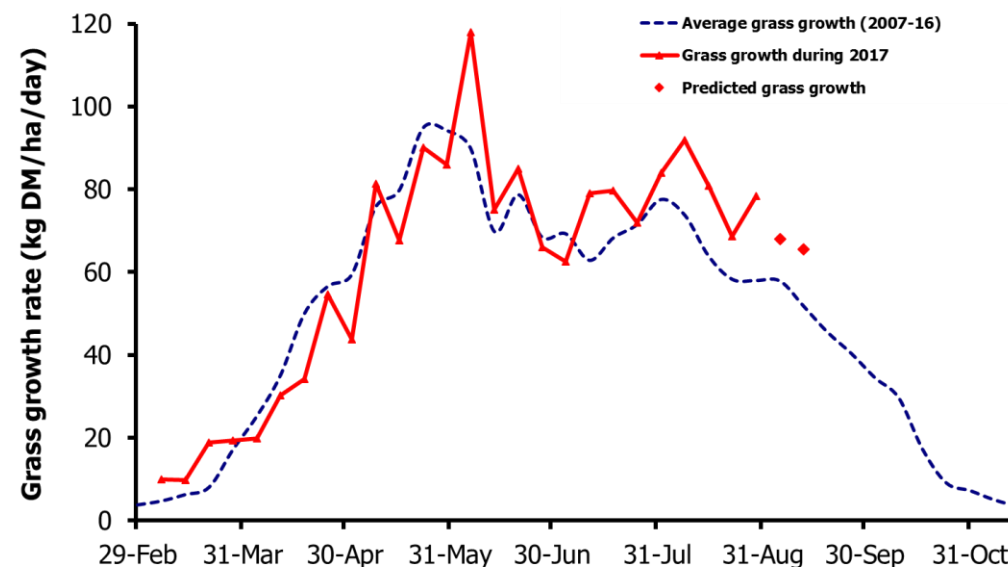
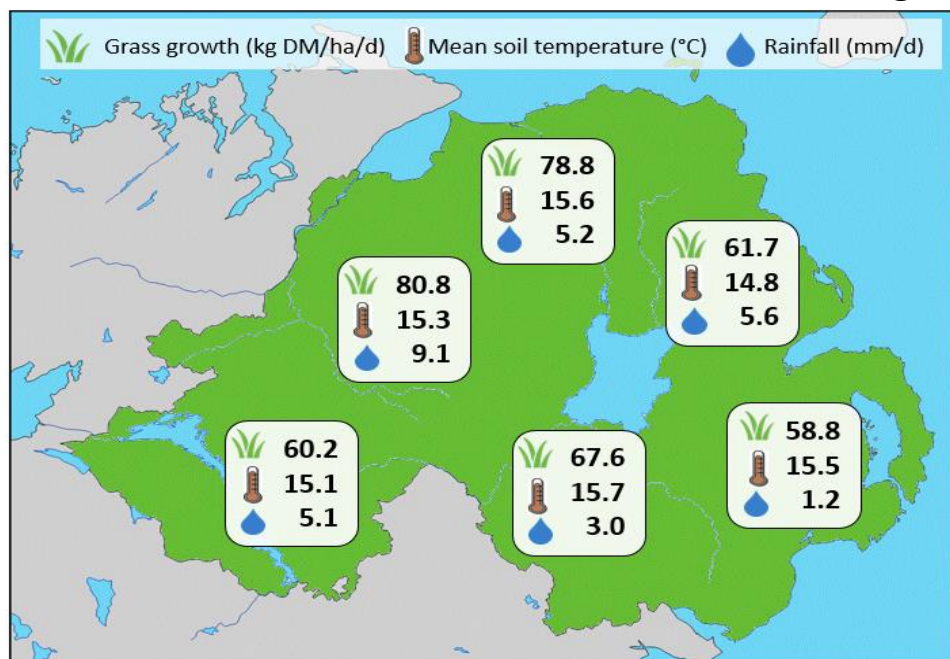


## Week Beginning 28 August 2017



### MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Extreme rainfall in the past week has caused ground conditions to deteriorate further across most of the province, with GrassCheck weather stations recording in excess of 50mm in an 8-hour period on 22 August.
- Despite this grass growth rates have remained strong, supported by average soil temperatures of 15.3°C
- Poor conditions are also having a knock-on effect on grass quality with below average dry matter and metabolisable energy contents for this time of year.
