

Management notes.

- Growth remains higher than normal, due to the current warm spell. Next week's yields are also expected to be higher than average.
- With the 'closed period' for sowing chemical fertiliser fast approaching, (15th September), ensure that applications are up to date, to promote autumn growth.
- All available grassland should be brought into the grazing cycle, to aid the build up of grass for utilisation later in the autumn, when growth rates decrease.
- Take a flexible approach to grazing management to improve performance.
- As days get shorter, grass intakes will decrease, so parlour settings should be adjusted to take this into account.
