## MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Growth remains above average for the time of year, despite the seasonal decline. However, there is a considerable variation across farms.
- With the improved weather grass growth is set to remain above the seasonal average for the coming week.
- Grazing paddocks out cleanly in the autumn is important to ensure a high-quality supply grass next spring:
  - $\,\circ\,\,$  Where ground conditions allow, graze out the paddocks cleanly.
  - Where ground conditions are marginal consider back fencing or using lighter stock.
  - For those that are housed look for opportunities to get stock out again
