











Grass Growth – AFBI Hillsborough and CAFRE Greenmount Plots

MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Grass growth on farm remains strong, above plot growth and the LT. av. The 7-day grass growth forecast is 6kg/day above the LT. av. Soil moisture and temperatures are good.
- Grass quality has reduced on farm, which coupled with lower DM% means so has animal performance. Adjust feeding rates/allocations for milking and beef animals accordingly.
- The majority of Grasscheck farms have growth rates in excess of demand. When taking out areas of surplus grass, target areas with poorer grass quality to clean up swards.
- Now is an opportune time to consider additional areas for reseeding given grass growth, silage stocks on farm and farm income. Reseeds will produce a boost in grass growths in the first two years, especially in the spring and autumn when grass is most valuable.
- Now is an opportune time for lime applications, plan in line with soil analysis results.
